Our key events include:

BLACK HISTORY MONTH

After two years of increasing awareness around the structural racism embedded within our cultural institutions, RAG want to spend time in October to ensure the vital work of anti-racist activism and empowerment continues here at Leeds. We will host a range of talks, events and promotions for Leeds and Yorkshire-based charities who support people of colour and minority ethnic communities, as well as ensuring our members and committee engage in anti-racist practices throughout the year.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

Our work with Women For Women International this year will pave the way for a series of events that celebrate female-identifying people in the Leeds community and beyond. Leeds RAG will be making connections with the incredible societies right here in the LUU that support our female peers to raise funds for women's liberation, safety, and wellbeing.

LGBTQ AWARENESS MONTH

Queer identities are continually under threat by a wave of discriminatory legal battles and social prejudice. Leeds RAG wish to use the platform of Pride Month to support local charities and communities that offer protection and solidarity to those who identify as part of the LGBTQ+ community.

INTERNATIONAL MEN'S DAY

Suicide is still one of the leading causes of death for men under 50. This year, Leeds RAG wants to take the time to acknowledge the social pressure on our male-identifying peers to conform to harmful patriarchal standards. Focusing on mental health, toxic masculinity and communication skills, we will be holding events that highlight the benefits of supporting men with their mental health and empowering them to challenge the expectations of our culture.

SOFT POWER EDUCATION



For 23 years, they have focused on providing an alternative, free of charge education to children from the communities of Kyabirwa and Buwenda as well as therapy and educational support to over 150 families with children with special needs.

RAG and Soft Power Education are keen to recruit volunteers who have realistic expectations of volunteering in remote areas abroad. Dates and fees for 2023 are to be confirmed, however, volunteers will likely arrive in Uganda anytime between May and August for 4 weeks.






THREE PEAKS TREK
